

At-Home Installation Art

For this assignment, you will create your own installation at home! **Installation art** is an artistic genre of **three-dimensional** works that are designed to transform the perception of a space & the surrounding environment. The **distinct qualities** of this form of **art** is that there is a relationship between the performer and the audience.

Requirements:

- This should be a large scale piece (take up at least the corner of a room or underneath a large table) that can be experienced by the members of your family! OR if you do not have the space or you're not allowed to decorate a room, you can create a model of a room with your installation in it; using a shoebox or a cardboard box. Like a diorama (image to the right).
 - It should allow the viewers to interact with it in some way - walking into a room, hearing something, watching a video, touching the art, experience lighting, etc.
- **Unless you are doing the shoebox option.**



Ideas:

- Can be indoors or outdoors (if outdoors, let someone know where you are at all times)
- Materials you could use: string lights, tinfoil, mirrors, paper, tape, balloons, radio, CPU, laser lights, stuffed animals, toy cars, ANYTHING

Project Breakdown:

Part One:

- Begin brainstorming ideas. ***Look at multiple examples online.
- Find a location (your room, the backyard, under a table, shoebox, etc)
- Gather materials

Part Two:

- Create your installation
- On the final day, “open” your installation to your viewers. Take photos or videos of them interacting with your installation.
- Upload a photo of your finished installation AND your viewers’ experience of it.
