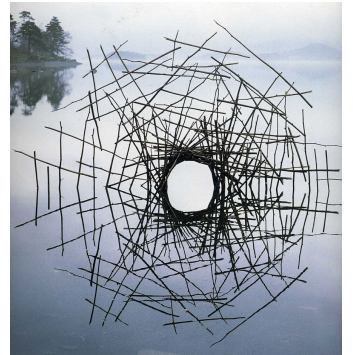


Andy Goldsworthy: Nature Sculpture

Artist:

Andy Goldsworthy is an artist who utilizes *nature as a sculptural medium*. His pieces are created and displayed outside. These pieces are only known to exist because Andy takes a photo of them before time and nature destroys them.



Assignment:

For this assignment, you will construct a 3D sculpture out of natural materials that you find outside! It can be as simple as arranging leaves, or as complex as interlocking sticks. Do not use glue or yarn to assemble your sculpture.

Materials to Consider:

- Leaves
- Rocks, dirt
- Sticks, branches, twigs
- Ice/snow
- Flowers



Assignment Break Down:

Part One:

- Find a location (your backyard, the woods, etc.)
- Think of ideas and begin gathering materials- be prepared to share a photo of your materials

Part Two:

- Finish gathering materials
- Create sculpture
- Upload photos of your sculpture from various angles
